## Permission to Reuse/Reprint AAPS Electronic Journal Material

For permission to reuse/reprint AAPS electronic journal material in a journal, book, proceedings volume, post on a commercial website, anthology, etc, requests must be sent by mail, email, or fax to the AAPS Editorial Office and include the following information about the original material:

1. Requestor's full name, affiliation, and title.
2. Requestor's complete mailing address, phone number, fax number, and email address.
3. *AAPS Journal* or *AAPS PharmSciTech* authors' names.
4. *AAPS Journal* or *AAPS PharmSciTech* article title.
5. *AAPS Journal* or *AAPS PharmSciTech* volume number, issue number, and DOI.
6. Page numbers of items to be reproduced.
7. Figure/table number or portion of text to be reused/reprinted.

Also include the following information about the intended use of the AAPS material:

1. Title of work in which *AAPS Journal* or *AAPS PharmSciTech* material will appear.
2. Authors/editors of work.
3. Publisher of work.
4. Retail price of work.
5. Number of copies of work to be produced.
6. Intended audience.
7. Whether work is for nonprofit or commercial use.

Authors whose work will be reused/reprinted will be notified. AAPS cannot supply original artwork. Use of AAPS material does not imply any endorsement by AAPS. The full journal reference is to be cited using the AMA Style Guide, 9<sup>th</sup> Edition.
